What does a MET Technician do?

While the type of work carried out will vary according to location, some of the typical day to day duties include:

- Removing and fitting basic mechanical, electrical and trim components
- Removing and refitting non-structural body panels
- Removing, renewing and refitting mechanical and electrical systems and vehicle trims following accident damage
- Carrying out vehicle inspections
- Identifying the extent of vehicle damage
- Accessing and removing damage components
- Installing new components
- Using specialist equipment and techniques including Vehicle Diagnostic machine, Four Wheel Alignment equipment to name a few.

Once you are qualified as a Vehicle MET Technician, there are a number of career paths open to you. Take a look to see where your career path could take you.

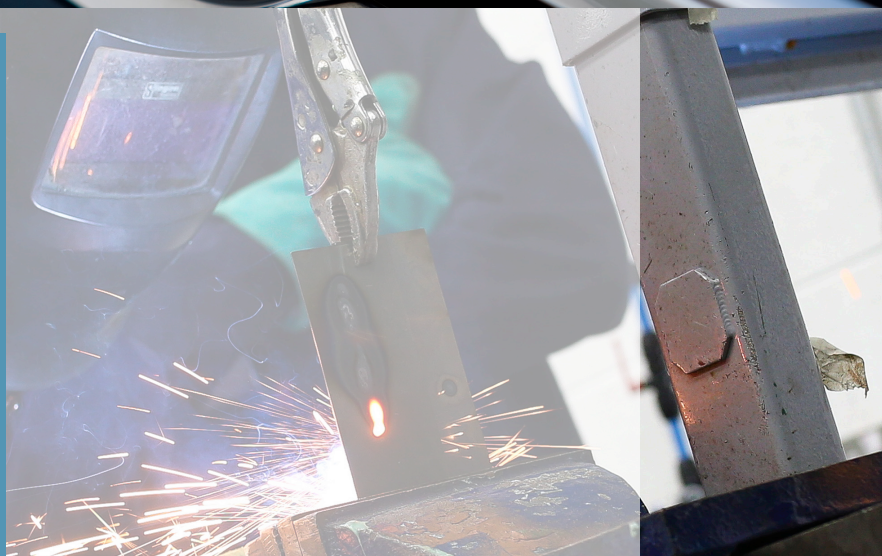


Apprenticeship vs. University
